

CERVICAL SCREENING & PREGNANCY



Cervical Screening, often called a smear test, is offered **FREE** by the NHS to all women and anyone with a cervix aged **25-64**.

Everyone eligible is sent an invitation **every three years** between the ages 25-49, then **every five years** from aged 50 to 64.

If you think your invite is late or you have missed an appointment, you can book this at your **GP surgery**.

If you're pregnant, you should usually wait **at least 12 weeks after you've given birth** before going for cervical screening.

Remember, the earlier that cervical cancer is detected, the better!

Screening can detect cancer at its early stages and sometimes before it even has a chance to develop.
