## CERVICAL SCREENING & PREGNANCY



Cervical Screening, often called a smear test, is offered FREE by the NHS to all women and anyone with a cervix aged 25-64.

Everyone eligible is sent an invitation **every three years** between the ages 25-49, then **every five years** from aged 50 to 64.

If you think your invite is late or you have missed an appointment, you can book this at your **GP surgery**.

If you're pregnant, you should usually wait at least 12 weeks after you've given birth before going for cervical screening.

Early detection saves lives!

Remember, the earlier that cervical cancer is detected, the better!

Screening can detect cancer at its early stages and sometimes before it even has a chance to develop.
