

# CERVICAL SCREENING & PREGNANCY



**Cervical Screening**, often called a smear test, is offered **FREE** by the NHS to all women and anyone with a cervix **every five years from age 25-64.**

If you think your invite is late or you have missed an appointment, you can book this at your **GP surgery**.

If you're pregnant, you should usually wait **at least 12 weeks after you've given birth** before going for cervical screening.

**Early

**Remember, the earlier that cervical cancer is detected, the better!**

**Screening can detect cancer at its early stages and sometimes before it even has a chance to develop.**
