CERVICAL SCREENING & PREGNANCY



Cervical Screening, often called a smear test, is offered FREE by the NHS to all women and anyone with a cervix every five years from age 25-64.

If you think your invite is late or you have missed an appointment, you can book this at your **GP surgery**.

If you're pregnant, you should usually wait at least 12 weeks after you've given birth before going for cervical screening.



Remember, the earlier that cervical cancer is detected, the better!

Screening can detect cancer at its early stages and sometimes before it even has a chance to develop.
